A WORD ABOUT THE LESSONS

Delivered from Sin and Death, You Now Live before God in the Righteousness of Christ -The outcome of sin is death, "*but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord*" (Rom. 6:23). He has set you free from the slavery of sin and has brought you "*from death to life*" (Rom. 6:13). No longer are you under the condemnation of the Law, but you live "*under grace*" (Rom. 6:14). Such is your courage in the face of "*those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul*" (Matt. 10:28).
