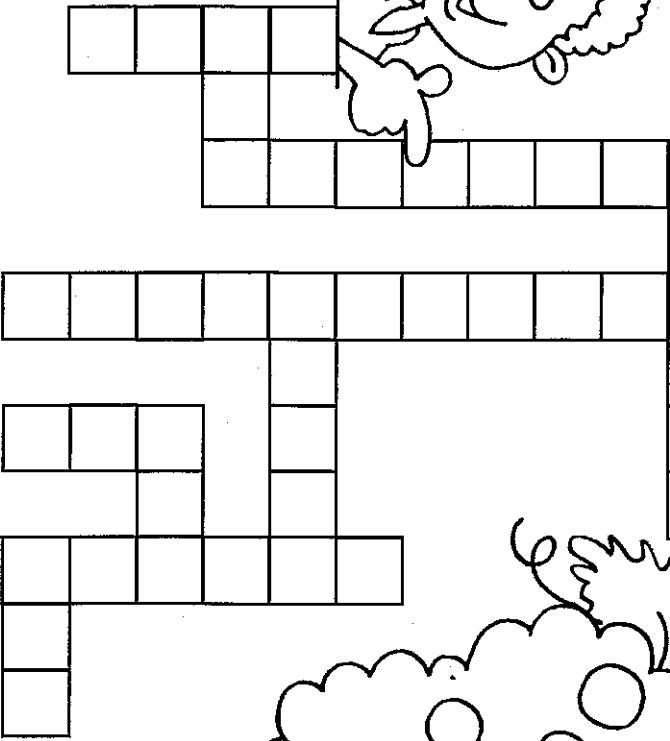
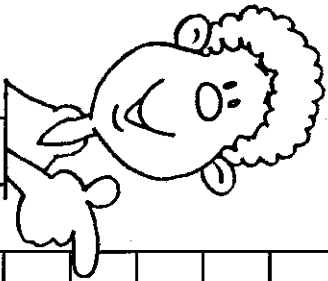
CROSSWORD PUZZLE

Try to fit words from today's Gospel into the crossword puzzle. (If you need help, use the word list.)

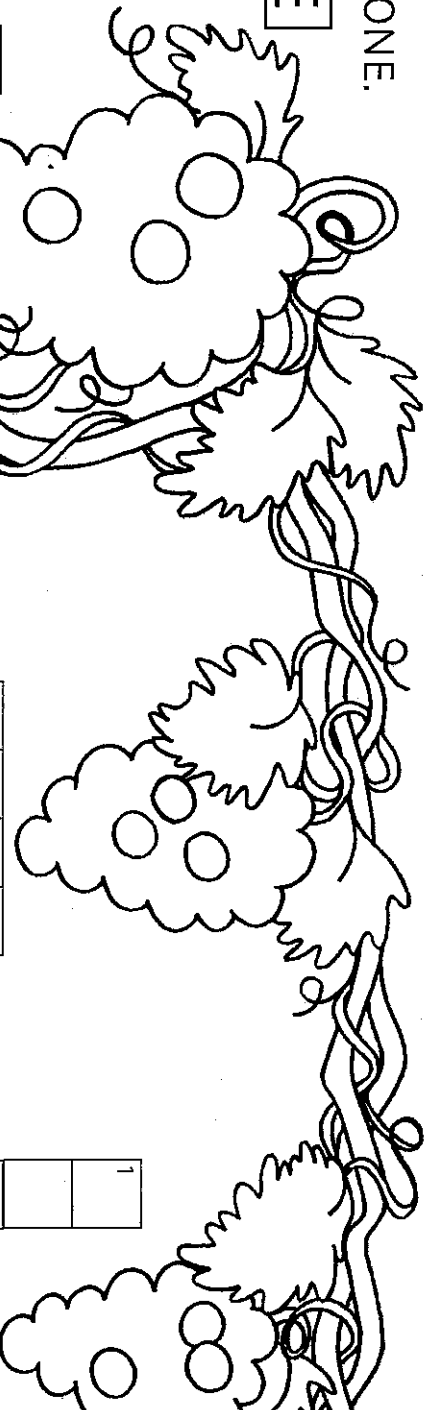
